

# Traffic Safety Guidelines for EDGE

The Safety of our children is a most important concern for all who participate in the Religious Education Program. In order to ensure a safe and orderly procedure for leaving and picking up students, please read the following directions carefully.

## *To drop off students in grades 6-8 (EDGE Nights):*

- 1) Form a line in the back of the parking lot (and along the sidewalk in front of the PLC)
- 2) When your car reaches the sidewalk, let your student out of the car then pull away allowing for the next car to pull up.

## *To pick up students in grades 6 - 8 (EDGE Nights):*

- 1) Form a line along the back of the parking lot (and along the sidewalk in front of the PLC)
- 2) Leaders will escort students to the pick up (sidewalk in front of PLC) area and wait for parents to pick up children.
- 3) After students are in the car, pull out of the line, using the left lane. Exit the parking lot.

- Do not leave vehicles parked next to the sidewalk.
- Vehicles must not be left running and unattended.
- Be courteous to fellow parents and volunteers.

## For the safety of the students:

- students will not be allowed to cross the drop off line at any time!
