

2nd Grade – “First Reconciliation”

Objective: To prepare a booklet the students may use during their First Reconciliation and then keep as a remembrance.

Materials:

- Light purple construction paper folded in half
- Student copy of “Reconciliation”
- Glue sticks
- Craft foam cross stickers
- Markers/colored pencils/crayons

Directions:

- Have students glue full sheet of paper entitled “Reconciliation” on the inside of the purple cover
- Have students decorate the covers of their booklets using a foam cross; have them include their names and the date of their First Reconciliation if possible
- Explain to the class that they may bring this special booklet and use it during their First Reconciliation. Read through the booklet as a class and use it to practice

Possible Extensions:

- Have your students draw a picture of themselves on the day of their First Reconciliation on the inside cover. This can be done before or after their special day
- Encourage your students to use the inside cover or back cover to write down how they felt after receiving their First Reconciliation
