

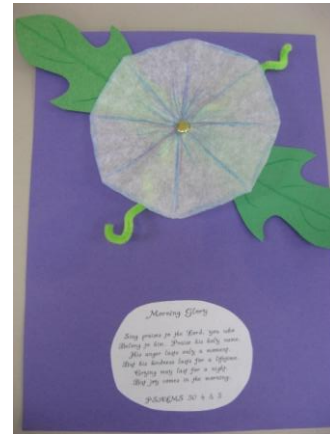
5th Grade – April Project

“Morning Glory”

Objective: This project symbolizes how Jesus’ death was so sad and dark, yet so joyful and full of light when he had risen. There will be times in our lives where we feel we’re in a dark night, but remember, when we place our trust in Jesus, the morning light will come!

Materials:

- Full sheet of construction paper
- Coffee filters
- 2 leaf patterns
- Paper fasteners
- Green pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- Crayons (blue and purple)
- Glue or glue sticks
- Morning Glory Passage
- pencil



Directions:

- Have students cut out the leaves – be careful to cut 2 at once
- Fold coffee filter 3X (like a snowflake)
- About 2 ½” from the point, cut straight across and open
- Use blue and purple crayons to outline the flower and highlight lines
- Use a sharp pencil to carefully poke a hole through center of flower and insert fastener
- Wrap pipe cleaner around fastener and curl
- Poke a hole through bottom center of leaves
- Poke a hole through the large sheet of construction paper where you will attach the flower
- Put the fastener through the leaves and background paper then fasten
- Glue on Morning Glory passage
