

5th Grade – January Project

“The Life of Jesus Paper Quilt”

Objective: Students reflect on Jesus’ life as an example of how he loved us and how to be a friend.

Materials:

- construction paper squares
- crayons/makers
- tape

Directions:

- Assign each student a period of Jesus’ life to depict on a quilt square
- With a marker, draw dashed lines around the perimeter of the square (to make it look like stitch marks)
- Arrange squares in chronological order, making equal rows (if you have an odd number, you can make an extra square with the class name and time or make up a name for your quilt, etc.)
- Tape the squares together on the back side (they can be taken apart later and sent home with students)
- Finished quilts can be turned in to be hung on the 5th grade bulletin board. Make sure the student’s first name only and class day/time is on each square to ensure children get it back when the display is taken down
